Orange Wig Day for Schools

Option 1: We are happy to supply wigs for large school groups providing the school is comfortable enforcing a donation to at least cover the costs of the wigs, which would be approx. £2.50 each. To place a bulk order, please email carey@anaphylaxis.org.uk.

Option 2: To allow all students to participate without donating, but still raising awareness, schools are invited to hold a mufti day where students wear orange instead of everyone wearing a wig. Activity Ideas

- Fashion show students could organise the show to showcase their best orange outfits.
 - Rather than students wearing wigs or orange clothing, the headteacher could set a target for fundraising if that target is reached, he/she will wear a wig or silly orange clothing for the day.



- Invite students with allergies to speak at an assembly about their allergies and what other children can do to help them stay safe.
- Work our NEW educational activity sheets into the learning programme on the week leading up to Orange Wig Day. The pack includes a word search, allergy true or false quiz, facts about allergies and more.
